## What is WARE?

WARE is a password protected site featuring the profiles of youth in foster care and Washington State families who are looking to adopt. WARE empowers social workers and featured families to make important connections that lead to permanency.

We partner with the Washington State Department of Children Youth and Families to help create more opportunities for youth to find permanency.

## Who is WARE for?

Washington State families with completed home studies, Washington state social workers, and youth hoping to be adopted from foster care.



## What are the benefits of WARE?

- ▶ When logged into WARE, families can connect with youth social workers directly, be the first to learn about upcoming events, and create their own family profile.
- ▶ The WARE team is available to answer any questions families might have, assist in creating family profiles, and keep families up-to-date on current events.
- ▶ WARE is a free service that families can use to do all of the above.
